# FROM FATHER SIMON

About 1.9 million students in close to 6400 Catholic elementary and secondary schools all over the country, including 210 in the Archdiocese of Chicago, celebrate Catholic Schools Week from January 27 to February 1 with special Masses, community service projects, academic and artistic showcases and athletic and family events.

The theme this year is “Catholic Schools: Learn. Serve. Lead. Succeed.” encompasses the core products and values that can be found in Catholic schools across the country. Not only are we teaching students to become future servant leaders, faith-filled disciples and enriched citizens in our communities, we, as educators, are growing with them. In Catholic schools, we are all learners, servants and leaders. These shared qualities are what make Catholic schools work. They are what make Catholic schools succeed.

The theme focuses on key elements of Catholic education: faith development, academic excellence and dedication to service. These elements set Catholic schools apart from other educational options. They are why families make sacrifices to provide their children with a Catholic education.

As I thank you parents for your sacrifice and commitment to Catholic education, I bring to your attention words from the special blessing given to the father of a child at baptism - “He and his wife will be the first teachers of their child in the ways of faith”. The first educators in the faith are parents. It is you, above all others, who establish in your children the first sensitivity and responsiveness to the presence of God, to the practice of prayer and to the patterns of life in the community of faith, the parish. By your example in the home and in your participation in the Mass and other sacraments, the foundations of life-long faith and discipleship in your children are laid down.

The faith development of a child isn't the only reason why parents send their children to Queen of All Saints School. Children of our school receive an excellent education that is academically demanding and authentically Catholic. I am proud of the fact that we are one of 49 non-public schools to receive the honor of being a National Blue Ribbon School. The Blue Ribbon Schools Program recognizes schools whose students achieve at very high levels. This award is a testament to the dedication and hard work of our principal and faculty. At Queen of All Saints School we are constantly striving to ensure that the academic program we deliver meets the needs of our students while encouraging them to do their best.

We make every effort to provide the necessary facilities and resources to our students so they can learn, serve, lead and succeed not only today but in tomorrow's challenging world. In the new school year 2019 - 2020 we will have an entirely new facility for our three-year-old and four-year-old programs with air-conditioned classrooms and state-of-the-art technology in a safe and healthy environment. The new science lab, a brand new music room and a resource center will help prepare the students for the future.

One of the great joys I have had over Christmas break was to see so many of our alumni who have graduated from our school in the past nine years at Mass. Many of them shared with me where life's journey has brought them and how proud they are of the education they received here. A couple of them served as ushers and lectors while home for Christmas.

# SCHOOL REGISTRATION

---



Registration for new and transfer students wishing to enter QAS School in August, 2019, will begin **TODAY**, after the 11 a.m. Catholic Schools Week Eucharist. Registration will be held from 12:15 until 1:45 p.m. in the Holy Name Room, along with our Curriculum Fair and Open House.

Registration application requests after today can be picked up in the Main School Office between 9:00am and 1:00pm, or call us at 773-736-0567.

## FOR REGISTRATION:

Please present a **Birth Certificate** (not the hospital certificate) for all new students.

Please present a **Baptismal Certificate** for all new students.

4-year-old pre-k through Grade 8 children transferring from other schools (public, private or parochial) will be accepted on an individual basis.

At the time of registration, copies of the most current progress report, report card and standardized testing are to be submitted with all registration forms.

There is a \$50.00 non-refundable registration fee per child for 3-year-old pre-k and 4-year-old pre-k and a \$200.00 non-refundable registration fee per family for kindergarten through grade 8, which will be applied toward tuition.

## AGE REQUIREMENTS:

3-year-old pre-k: child must be 3 years of age by September 1, 2019

4-year-old pre-k: child must be 4 years of age by September 1, 2019

Kindergarten: child must be 5 years of age by September 1, 2019

Grade One: child must be 6 years of age by September 1, 2019

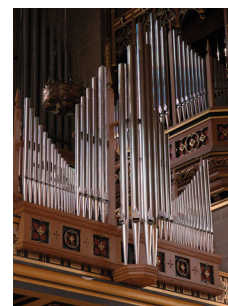

## The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year, at 1:30pm. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A Baptismal Preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must also be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

## The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

## Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.
