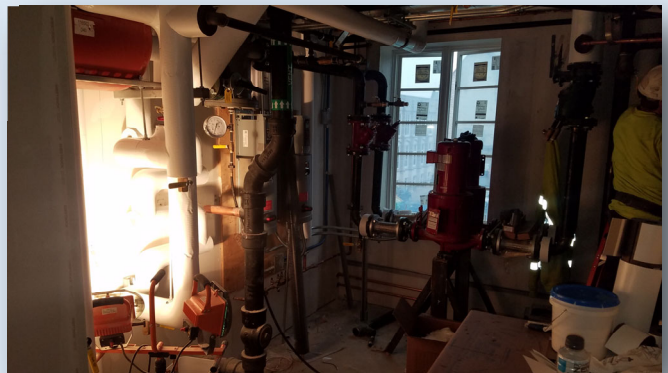

Save the date for our annual blood drive. This year we will have a donation bus provided by Heartland Blood Center in the parking lot.

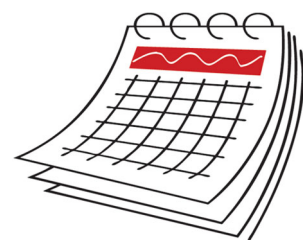

IT'S OUR TURN

Unless you were here in the late 1950s when our church was under construction you might think our Basilica and our other buildings were always here and always will be.

But we know that it took a lot of hard work and a lot of very generous giving to fund our magnificent church, from people just like us who sat in the pews we sit in today.

The financial challenge faced by those who came before us was to construct our parish buildings. **Our challenge today is to maintain and enhance those buildings.** As you decide on your level of support for our parish, please consider:

- Our parish capital campaign construction project is fully underway, with the comprehensive renovation and repurposing of our former convent and Benedict Center, as well as repairs and improvements to both the Keene and Lemont buildings. **Please keep current on your pledge so that our project can stay on schedule, and consider whether your circumstances might allow you to increase your earlier pledge.**
- Repair and maintenance costs for the Basilica especially have risen dramatically in recent years, including the unexpected replacement of the ceiling and the current work on the Bell Tower. **We were forced to borrow from our savings to pay for these repairs and will need your increased Sunday collections to replenish our savings.**

Whatever your decision, please know that we are always grateful for your full participation, including your attendance at Mass, your volunteer work in our many ministries, and your financial support.

The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year, at 1:30pm. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A Baptismal Preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must also be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.
