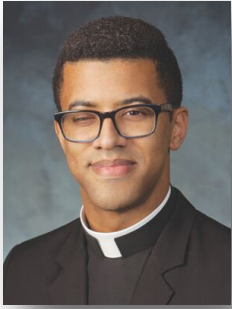

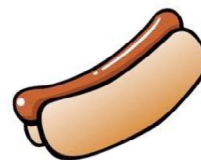

Religious Education News

Registration for Religious Education 2019-2020 is now open!

The QASRE program begins at kindergarten and goes through eighth grade. Our program focuses on building Christ's disciples who will go out and glorify the Lord by their lives.

Students wanting to participate in the sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation must attend a minimum of two years of Religious Education as per the archdiocesan requirement. First Reconciliation and Communion preparation begins at 1st grade. Confirmation preparation begins at 7th grade.

School Registration



Please present a birth certificate (not the hospital certificate) and baptismal certificate for all new students.

4-year-old Preschool to Grade 8 children transferring from other schools – public, private or parochial, will be accepted on an individual basis. At the time of registration, copies of the most current progress report, report card and standardized testing are to be submitted with all registration forms.

There is a \$50.00 non-refundable registration fee per child for 3-year-old Preschool and 4-year-old Preschool and a \$200.00 non-refundable registration fee per family for Kindergarten through Grade 8, which will be applied toward tuition.

Age Requirements:

- Three-Year-Old Preschool: Child must be 3 years of age by September 1, 2019
- Four-Year-Old Preschool: Child must be 4 years of age by September 1, 2019
- Kindergarten: Child must be 5 years of age by September 1, 2019
- Grade One: Child must be 6 years of age by September 1, 2019

Legislative Alert

Governor J.B. Pritzker has let it be known that he wants to gradually dismantle and then eliminate the Tax Credit Scholarship program. In its first year, over 5,000 low income youngsters have been able to pay tuition to go to better schools - mostly Catholic schools.

A group of Democrat and Republican state legislators have proposed House Resolution 289 telling Gov. Pritzker to keep the Tuition Tax Credit Scholarship programs throughout its 5-year pilot program term.

Ten Queen of All Saints students have already benefited from the tax scholarship program.

There are currently twenty-one students on the waiting list.

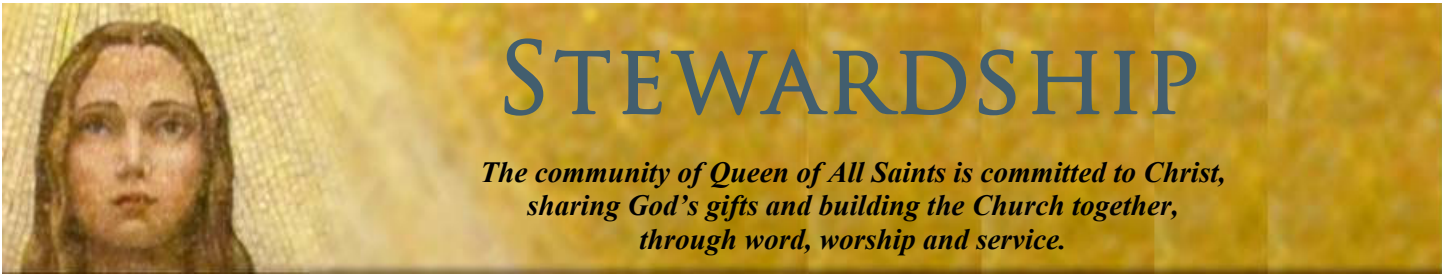

Our Capital Campaign: Entering a New Phase

We are approaching the end of Phase I of our capital campaign, the comprehensive renovation and repurposing of the Benedict Center:

- State-of-the-art classrooms for our 3- and 4-year-old early childhood education programs
- New gathering spaces for our adult ministries
- All new electrical wiring, plumbing and HVAC
- Dedicated space for our Special Religious Education Program
- Enhanced fire safety and security features, plus elevator access for the elderly and disabled.

We now look ahead to Phases II and III of our campaign:

- The renovation of the former kindergarten space for use by our larger ministries, including the Men's Club and Women's Auxiliary
- Reconfiguration of classrooms, library and music program into updated and more appropriate space
- Finally, the creation of a flexible parish community hall in the former Rose Room, restoring that space to its original form.

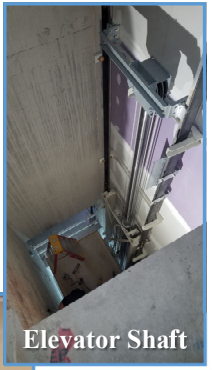

The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year, at 1:30pm. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A Baptismal Preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must also be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.
