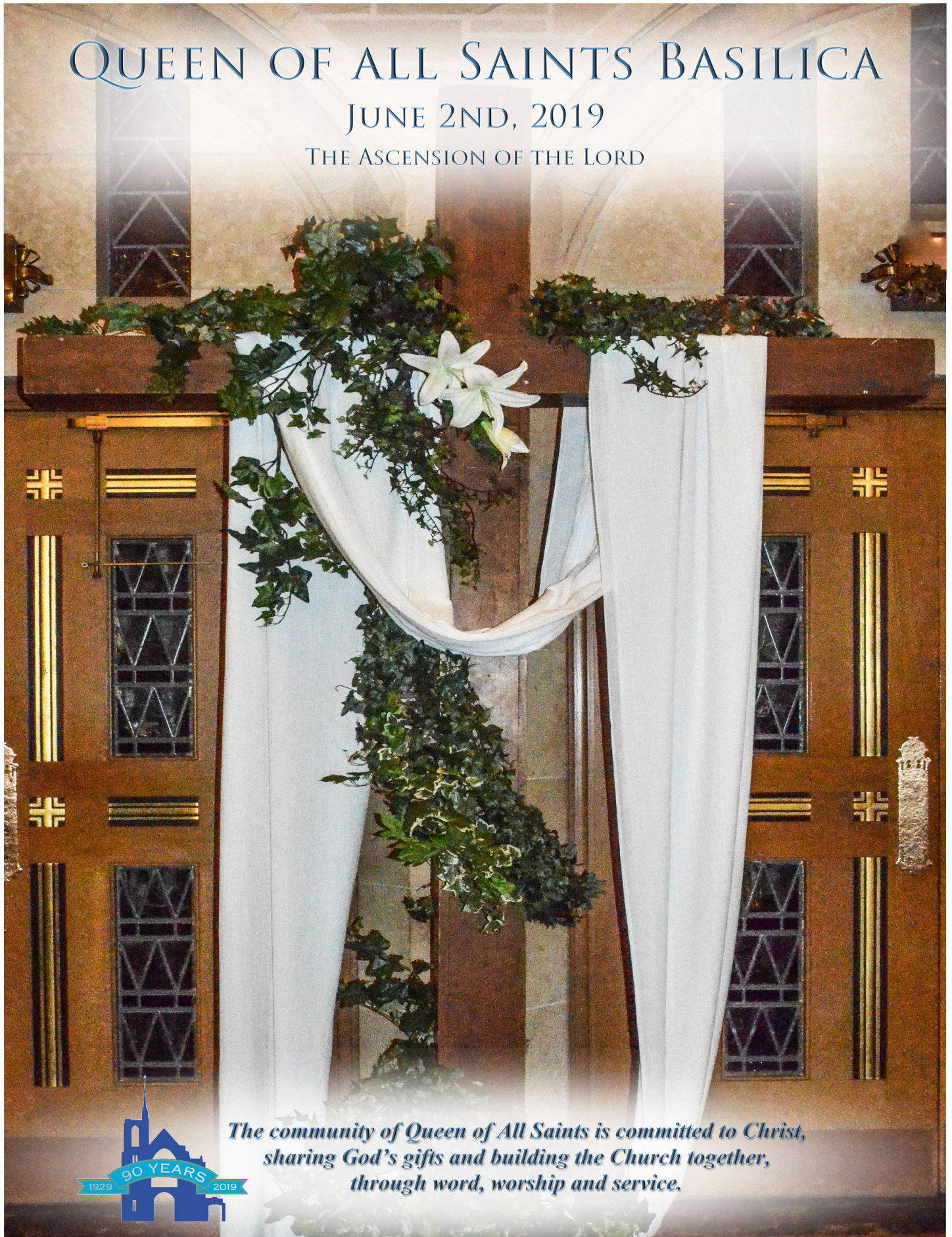

## FROM FATHER SIMON



It is clear from the accounts in the New Testament that there were certain high points that captured the imagination of Jesus' disciples in a way that they would willingly have stood still, those occasions when they probably asked themselves 'Why can't it always be like this?'

At the Transfiguration, Peter was so in awe of what was happening that he suggested building tents for Jesus and their visitors. It was as if he just wanted to cling onto the experience and stay on the mountain. He soon realized that was not possible, just as we do with our experiences. Time moves on.

Having to move on is a challenge that we repeatedly need to face. Parting from loved ones always has something of the bereavement experience about it, and of course the ultimate bereavement comes with death itself. It is then that we may gather the memorabilia to try and keep the person alive in our minds, but we know that the key is not really in the photographs or the videos – treasured as they may be – but rather in the depths of our hearts. It is there that the love lives on.

There is something of a parallel here with what happened to the disciples after the death of Jesus. In spite of the rumors of his resurrection, they begin to withdraw in fear and talk about returning to their previous ways of life. However, Jesus gradually helps them put the picture together. His Ascension provides the springboard for them to move on. Rather than witnessing the end of the ages, they were met and chastened by two men dressed in white, who asked rather humorously, "Why are you standing there looking at the sky?" God apparently was not yet finished with them. It confirmed that there was still work to be done – the same work that Jesus was doing when he was on earth. No matter how difficult and uncertain things become, the gospel now has to be written around the story of their lives and their faithfulness to Jesus. That is the challenge for us as well.

At this time of year, there are thousands across the country who are graduating from college, high school and grade school. They are not the only ones who are dealing with a significant change in their lives, the friends they leave behind and anxious parents who begin to realize their child will be moving to college are also trying to cope with change that sometimes makes us wonder 'Why can't it always be like it was?'

This past Friday, sixty eighth graders graduated from Queen of All Saints School. Some have spent as many as eleven years in our school. They are heading off to twelve different high schools in the Chicagoland area and around the country. We wish them the very best wherever their life's journey takes them. We ask you, our graduates, to always remember that you have a home here at Queen of All Saints parish.

This weekend we also bid farewell to Fr. Trail, Sr. Mary Lou and Mrs. Kristina Reyes. After a brief stay with us, Fr. Trail has been asked by the Archdiocese to minister at Mount Carmel parish. Sr. Mary Lou, after 25 years of dedicated service to our pre-school program has decided to retire and continue to serve her community in Phoenix, AZ. Mrs. Reyes, after three short years at QAS, during which time she helped us gain recognition as a National Blue Ribbon School, will take on the task of leading St. Joan of Arc Academy in Evanston. Please join the community as we thank them, wish them luck and ask for God's blessings at the parish BBQ. See you on the field.

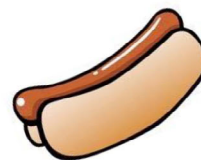

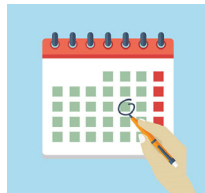

## Legislative Alert

Governor J.B. Pritzker has let it be known that he wants to gradually dismantle and then eliminate the Tax Credit Scholarship program. In its first year, over 5,000 low income youngsters have been able to pay tuition to go to better schools - mostly Catholic schools.

A group of Democrat and Republican state legislators have proposed House Resolution 289 asking Gov. Pritzker to continue the Tuition Tax Credit Scholarship program through the completion of its 5-year pilot term.

Ten Queen of All Saints students have already benefited from the tax scholarship program.

There are currently twenty-one students on the waiting list.

## Today's Readings

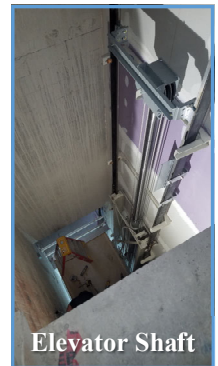
*"I am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end."*

## The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year, at 1:30pm. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A Baptismal Preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must also be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

## The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

## Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.
