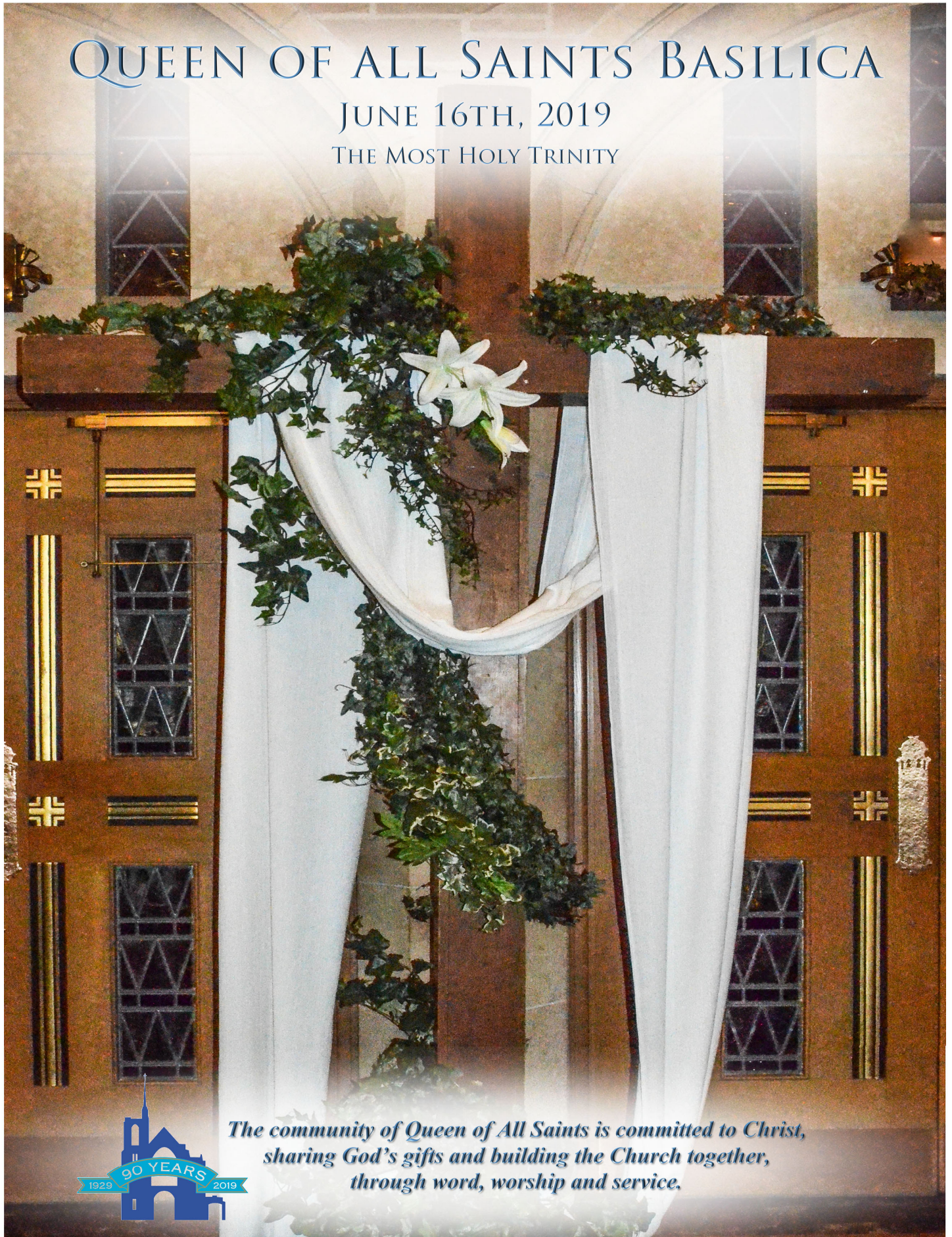

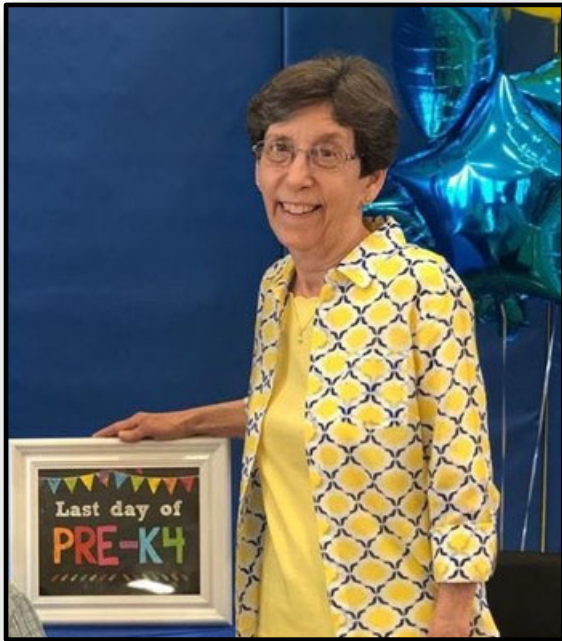


THE FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI

Religious Education News

Registration for Religious Education 2019-2020 is now open!

The QASRE program begins at kindergarten and goes through eighth grade. Our program focuses on building Christ's disciples who will go out and glorify the Lord by their lives.

Students wanting to participate in the sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation must attend a minimum of two years of Religious Education as per the archdiocesan requirement. First Reconciliation and Communion preparation begins at 1st grade. Confirmation preparation begins at 7th grade.

Our Capital Campaign is Entering a New Phrase

We are within days of the end of the construction portion of Phase I of our capital campaign - the comprehensive renovation and repurposing of the Benedict Center, and we will soon take occupancy of our long-dreamed space.

- State-of-the-art classrooms for our 3- and 4-year-old early childhood education programs.
- New gathering spaces for our adult ministries.
- All new electric wiring, plumbing and HVAC.
- Dedicated space for our Special Religious Education Program.
- Enhanced fire safety and security features, plus elevator access for the elderly and disabled.

We now look ahead to Phases II and III of our campaign:

- The renovation of the former kindergarten space for use by our larger ministries, including Men's Club and Women's Auxiliary.
- Reconfiguration of classrooms, library, music program into updated and more appropriate space.
- Finally, the creation of a flexible parish community hall in the former Rose Room, restoring that space to its original function.

To keep our construction schedule for Phases 2 and 3 in the Keene and Lemont buildings, we need to continue collecting our pledges without delay.

The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year, at 1:30pm. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A Baptismal Preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must also be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.
