FROM FATHER SIMON



One of the most influential stories told by Jesus is the parable of the Good Samaritan. As a result of this scripture, people all over the world, whether Christians or not, speak of being a Good Samaritan, of doing good for people who are in peril or need. Modern-day Good Samaritans stop to help stranded travelers, fix flat tires or find shelter, come to the rescue of people in distress or serve spontaneously as benevolent volunteers. They even receive legal immunity in many states should they happen to make matters worse while trying to be of help. Most people in modern society know the main details of the story of the Good Samaritan and this memorable story inspires benevolent daily decisions both socially and religiously. Because we all have serious needs, this parable speaks deeply to every human soul.

This well-known parable is provoked by two questions: 1) What must I do to inherit eternal life? and 2) Who is my neighbor? The parable and the punch line “Go and do likewise” have nothing to do with the law, theology or academics. Jesus didn’t say what a neighbor is or who a neighbor is.

We admire the compassion and strength of the Samaritan, but this is not something that comes suddenly when such love and compassion is actually needed. It is something that one has to cultivate each day, so that when a real test comes, we are up to the challenge. The Scribe’s question, “who is my neighbor?” could be paraphrased as “who deserves to receive my love?” In this parable, Jesus turns the question around, to mean in effect, “Who do you think was capable of giving compassion and love?” The Scribe is unable even to say the name “Samaritan”. He cannot, however, deny the Samaritan’s act of loving concern.

Many news items tell us of people casually walking past someone in great need of attention, be it because of an accident or a crime. Perhaps we may never be called upon to render assistance to such an unfortunate victim. We will, however, increasingly meet people of different race or religion. Certainly, people of different cultures are already part of our parish family. Will we show ourselves to be like the priest and the Levite and pass them by without even a kind word or salutation? Or will we be, as a true follower of Christ, a Good Samaritan and a true friend to all who are brothers and sisters in Christ.

This, like all Jesus’ teachings, is meant for us here and now. We must be able to apply them to ourselves in our own situation. The question he puts to us today is not who is worthy of receiving our neighborly love, but who is capable of giving it?

- FIRST FLOOR -



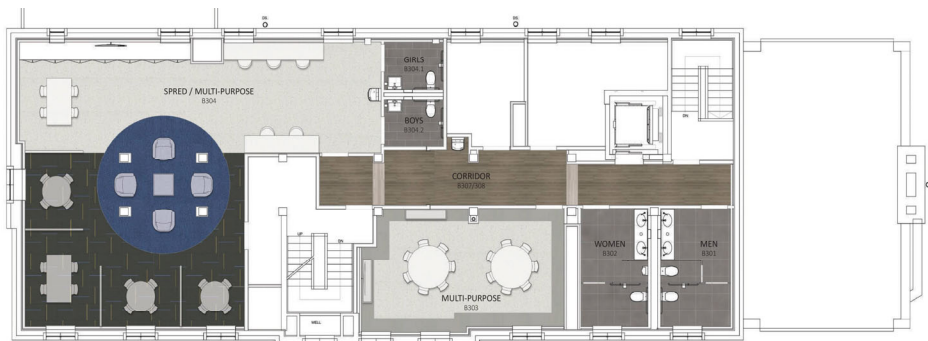

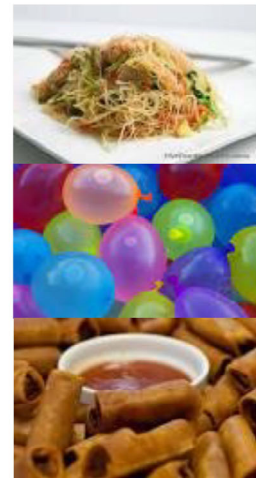

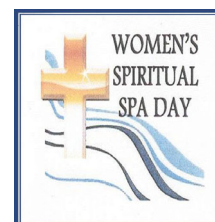

The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year, at 1:30pm. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A Baptismal Preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must also be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.
