## FROM FATHER SIMON



Can you believe Labor Day is just two weeks away? Our college students are headed back to college, those entering their first year on the way to orientation. Some of the high schools in the area have already started and in a week from now Queen of All Saints School will be in tip-top shape, ready for the students to return. Thank you to our amazing maintenance team and faithful teachers who are already thinking about getting their classrooms ready. The first day of school is Monday, August 26th and the opening school liturgy is September 6th at 2:00 pm. All school parents are invited!

In many ways, the opening of the school year kicks off a new season of faith formation programs, sacramental preparation programs, and adult faith formation. Our Religious Education classes will begin on Tuesday, September 17, adults interested in embracing the Catholic faith are invited to attend the RCIA information session on Sunday, September 8 following the 11am Mass and Catechetical Sunday will be celebrated on Sunday, September 15. Grade-level Masses will also start in September and the Youth Ministry will have their first Mass as a group on Sunday, September 8 at 4pm in the Benedict Center Chapel. Let the learning begin!

Years ago, the words ‘teaching’ and ‘learning’ would evoke images of a classroom, a blackboard, a lecture and taking notes. However, nowadays, even in elementary schools (certainly ours!), blackboards are gone, replaced by interactive ‘smart boards’. The teacher standing in front of class lecturing is almost passé. Learning groups and hands-on learning are now much more central. Hopefully we all realize learning is an interactive, multifaceted process, not just giving information to be absorbed. Not only that, most of us also understand that while we may not do it sitting in a classroom, we all do keep learning our whole life long.

Growing in our faith is at the heart of being church, along with worship, community building and service. *We Believe. We Belong. We Learn. We Grow in Christ.* Why should we learn about our faith? We do this because Jesus calls us into a life giving, saving relationship! Once we experience that relationship with Jesus, we want to know him better, we want to have a deeper relationship, and so we share with one another how we have experienced him as we strive to be a community that is ***committed to Christ, sharing God’s gifts and building Church together through Word, Worship and Service!***

You see them come forward for a blessing at the end of the 9:30am Mass each Sunday. They are your friends and neighbors who give generously of their time and care for our homebound parishioners. Every one of them will attest to the fact that in their ministry they receive more than they give.

Consider joining us as we endeavor to bring Communion, comfort and connection to those who cannot be with us.

A new course of formation, available through the *Ministers of Care Formation*, is designed with the person in mind who is interested in taking part in this parish ministry. While each session focuses on a particular aspect of the Ministry of Care, the unifying thread woven throughout is a commitment to help you develop skills and confidence needed to be a source of comfort to those who are sick. Completion of this course qualifies you to receive the Archdiocesan mandate to bring Communion to the sick, homebound and hospitalized of your parish.

Sessions will run two hours and will include a talk given by an experienced facilitator accompanied by group discussion and/or an exercise to help you practice a particular skill.

The RCIA is a process for those considering becoming Catholic.

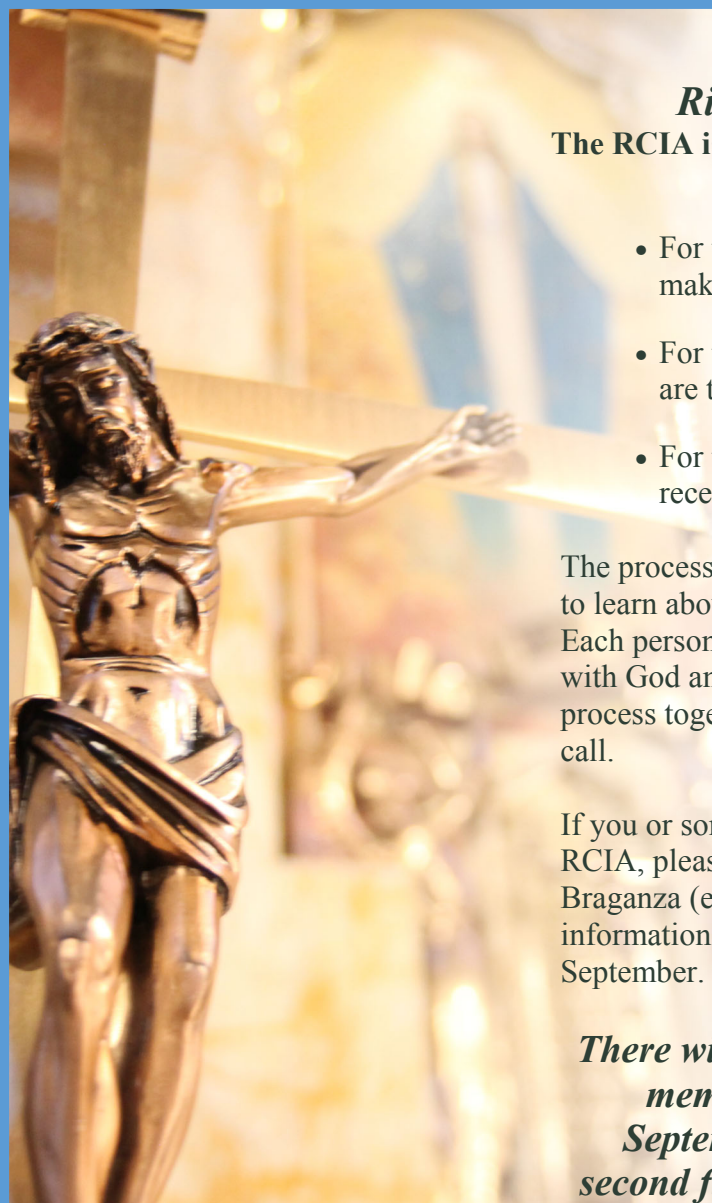
*Specifically, it is:*

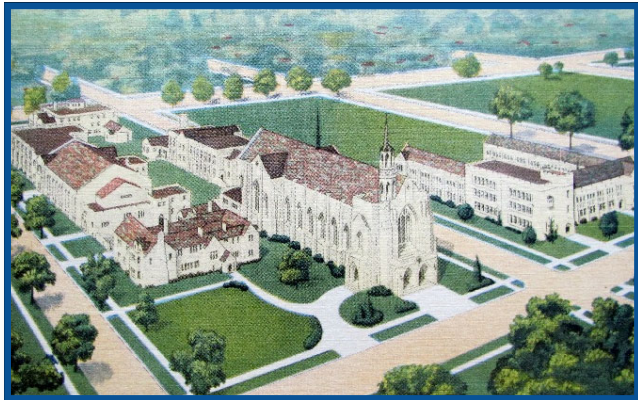

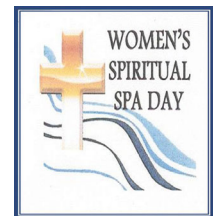

## The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year, at 1:30pm. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A Baptismal Preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must also be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

## The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

## Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.
