On August 26th, 2018, we gathered on the east side of the Benedict Center for the blessing of the building site that would be the focus of Phase I of our Capital Campaign *From Generation to Generation*. Our goal was threefold:

- 1) increase the square footage we use for gathering and learning, as well as retrofit our meeting spaces to be better suited to our meeting and gathering needs;
- 2) upgrade our facilities so that they are ADA-compliant and accessible to all. This will include the replacement of an unusable elevator with one that allows visitors of all abilities access to the Benedict Center and all that it offers;
- 3) improve electrical and plumbing systems, ensure fire safety and security and upgrade the technological capabilities of our campus.



Blessing the building site last August

On August 26, 2019, when Queen of All Saints School opens its doors to welcome students to a new school year for the 80th time, we will have completed not only Phase I but also Phase II of our Capital Campaign Project. Many of you have seen the work we accomplished in Phase I during the Open House on July 7th (*pictures on page four*). Phase II of our project has allowed us to provide:

- a new Music Room
- a new Science lab
- two renovated classrooms
- a new resource/media room
- a dedicated faculty lounge
- new offices for our Assistant Principal and Religious Education Department
- a new parish meeting space (“Holy Name Room”)

All of these new or renovated areas have new electrical, plumbing, HVAC and state-of-the-art technology.

While the students will be excited about the new / renovated facilities, I am also honored to welcome our new Principal, Mrs. Emily Carlson and Assistant Principal Mrs. Amy Moore. Both are committed to Catholic Education and are already working hard to provide an excellent academic education for our children that cultivates both body and soul, nurtures the spirit, and does it all within a safe, caring environment. Joining them are 7 new faculty and staff members who will not only teach but will be ministers to your children throughout their education. The generosity of our faculty and staff can never be taken for granted. I ask you to pray for our school each and every day and in a special way join all school faculty and students on September 6, 2019 at the 2 pm Mass where we will come together to ask for God's blessing on this new school year.

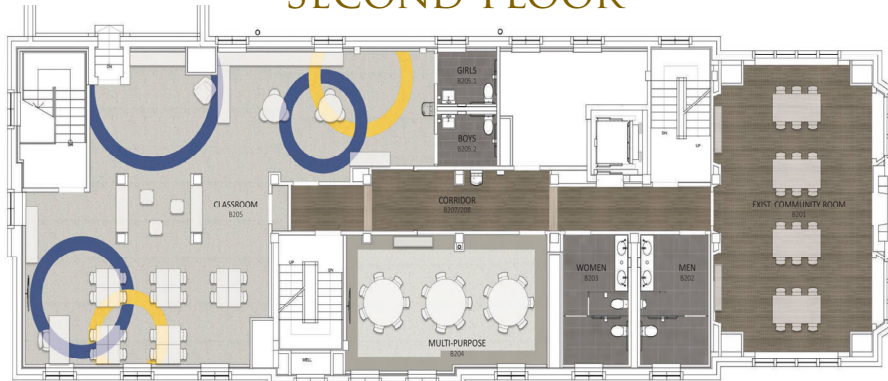
BENEDICT CENTER RENOVATION - PHASE I

- FIRST FLOOR -



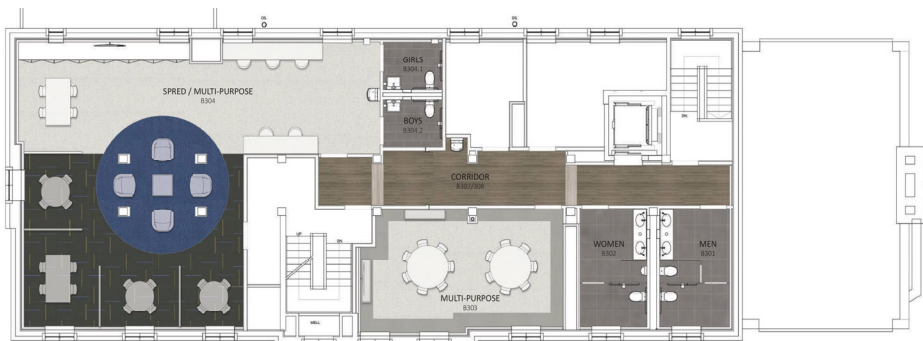
The first floor has newly renovated preschool classrooms and new bathrooms for the preschoolers and adults. There are four separate areas for the children to learn and play. The Benedict Center renovation included additional security, technology and air conditioning.

- SECOND FLOOR -



The second floor houses a new preschool classroom and new bathrooms for the preschoolers. The “Fireplace Room” has been renovated. Space was also allocated to include a new meeting room.

- THIRD FLOOR -



The third floor features the new SPRED meeting space with kitchenette along with an additional meeting room called the Council Room.

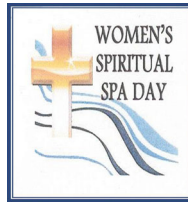

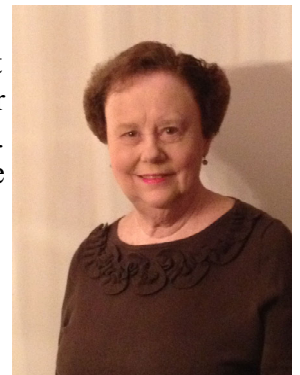

The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year, at 1:30pm. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A Baptismal Preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must also be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.
