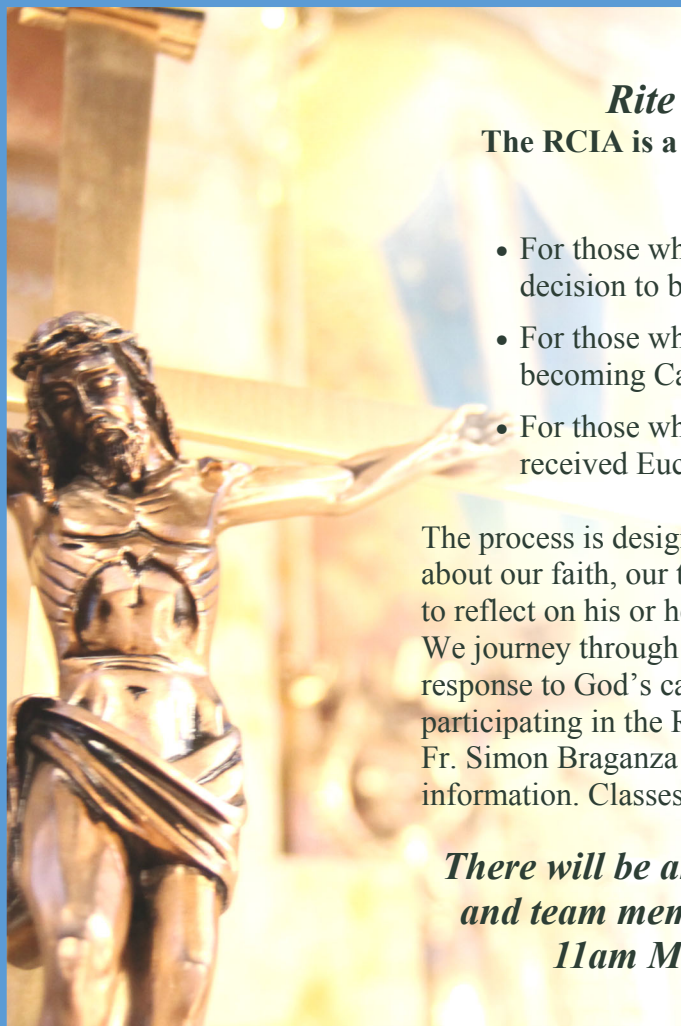

- For those who were baptized in another faith and are thinking of becoming Catholic
- For those who were baptized Roman Catholic and have not yet received Eucharist or Confirmation

The process is designed to assist those interested in Catholicism, to learn about our faith, our traditions, and our celebrations. Each person is invited to reflect on his or her own relationship with God and the faith community. We journey through this process together, assisting each other in our response to God's call. 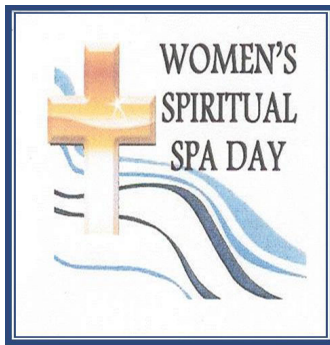

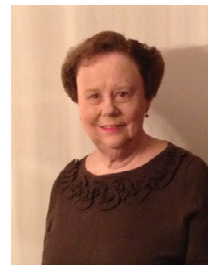

Registration

From the Archives

On March 16, 1992, Marine One landed with President George H.W. Bush on our large parking lot along the side of the basilica on his way to attend an event at the Polish National Alliance. The following excerpt is from then pastor Father Charles Cronin's bulletin article, written the weekend after President Bush's visit:

"On Friday afternoon, our parish secretary, Barb, told me one of my crank friends was on the phone and wanted permission to land President Bush on our property. Well it was the Secret Service and they were coming over to talk. They explained that the president was going to the Polish National Alliance and to avoid tying up the expressways, they would like to helicopter him in on our parking lot.

Last Sunday afternoon they had a test run and I was really impressed. They brought in five helicopters and I thought it was the middle of a *M.A.S.H.* production. I got so excited I talked my niece and nephew into coming over... Monday was more impressive with all the police, firemen and secret service people doing their thing, or not doing their thing. There were sharpshooters on the roof, special phone lines put in and the school evacuated. The president came early and surprised us all but it was a thrill.

Some people question the wisdom of the decision to allow the president to land on our parking lot... My feeling is that this is our president and if landing on our parking lot helps, well that's what a good neighbor is for."

The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year, at 1:30pm. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A Baptismal Preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must also be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.
