FROM FATHER SIMON



Last Tuesday, one of the columnists in the Chicago Tribune wrote ‘Christmas is Coming Fast: Here are the things you should be panicking about’. Among the nine ‘things’ he mentioned, twice he suggested that we should be ‘panicking’, if we are not already.

As we light the second candle on the Advent wreath, we hear one of the familiar voices of Advent, John the Baptist. He came to announce a new and radical message from a new place. John spoke this new message from the wilderness of the desert. He did not go to the crowds in the temple. They went to the desert to hear him. As the gospel tells us, ‘all of Judaea and the whole of the Jordan district made their way to him.’ Perhaps the people were tired and even bored of what they were hearing in temple. Perhaps John arrived at the right time with this new message. Their ears and hearts were open and ready to receive it.

The challenging question for us today is are our ears and hearts open to hear what John the Baptist has to say to us now, in our time? What is this message that John brings and that people went so far into the desert to hear? It is a message of repentance. Just as John asked the people of his time to look at their lives, today he asks us to look honestly at our lives. John asks us to change our lives and to prepare a way for the Lord.

Over these coming days and weeks of Advent, we will be busy in so many ways getting ready to celebrate the birth of Christ. There will be shopping for presents and gifts, buying food, cleaning and decorating our homes and writing Christmas cards. These are all a part of our preparation for the Christmas season. However, they are only one part of getting ready for Christmas. The words and message of John the Baptist echo down through the centuries and they are as relevant and important to us today as they were when John first proclaimed his message in the desert. We too are being called to repent, change, prepare a way for the Lord and to make his paths straight.

By the end of the gospel, John tells us whom he is announcing and to whom he is drawing attention. As we already know, it is Jesus Christ. If we only focus on and panic about the externals of getting ready to celebrate Christmas, we will miss not only someTHING, we will miss someONE.





Scholarship Opportunity

The Archdiocesan Council of Catholic Women (ACCW), offers a \$1,000 scholarship renewable for four years to the deserving young Catholic woman who can successfully articulate what it means to be a Catholic woman in the world today.

The applicant should currently be a high school senior. She does not have to attend a Catholic high school, nor does she have to select a Catholic college or university. The rules, criteria and application for the scholarship are available for download on the ACCW website: accw.archchicago.org.

You may also access our website via the Archdiocesan website, www.archchicago.org. If you use this website, select "Office Ministries" and click on "Archdiocesan Council of Catholic Women", then select the tab for "Scholarship."

ILLINOIS TAX CREDIT SCHOLARSHIPS



INCREASE STUDENT OPPORTUNITIES

The state program Invest in Kids offers a transformational opportunity for Archdiocese of Chicago Catholic Schools through tax credit scholarships (TCS). Children in our state from low-income families will have access to new scholarships to attend non-public schools. Tax credit scholarships cover up to 100 percent of tuition and fees for students. Scholarship eligibility is based on a family's income. For example, a student could receive a scholarship if his/her family income is less than \$72,900.

LOWER YOUR TAX BILL

Invest in Kids provides Illinois state income tax credits to individuals and corporations that contribute money to an approved Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO). SGOs are independent 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations that award scholarships to eligible students from low-income families. Individuals and corporations may receive a credit for their Illinois state taxes equal to 75 percent of donations to an SGO. Individuals can designate their donation to a school or subset of schools.

INVEST IN KIDS IN THREE EASY STEPS



1. APPLY FOR A TAX CREDIT AT MYTAX.ILLINOIS.GOV

Applicants are required to have a MyTax Illinois account. Visit archchicago.org/tcs for step-by-step instructions for creating an account and applying for the tax credit.



2. DONATE TO AN SGO WITHIN 60 DAYS

Once the application is approved, donate to a Scholarship Granting Organization, such as Empower Illinois or Big Shoulders Fund SGO, within 60 days.



3. DESIGNATE TO CHICAGO CATHOLIC SCHOOLS

During the donation process, donors have the option to donate to a specific Catholic school or the Archdiocese of Chicago Catholic Schools.

SCHOOL NEWS



Dear Parishioner,

Queen of All Saints School is grateful to you for supporting the advancement of Catholic school education. I am writing about a unique opportunity for Archdiocese of Chicago Catholic schools. The State of Illinois created a tax credit scholarship program through the “Invest in Kids” Act that is mutually beneficial to students and donors. It provides a 75 percent Illinois State income tax credit to individuals who contribute money to fund scholarships for students to attend private schools. Eligible students from low-income families in Illinois may use these scholarships to attend a non-public school of their choice, including the more than 200 Archdiocese of Chicago Catholic schools in Cook and Lake Counties.

To increase the funds available for scholarships next year, several donors have partnered with the scholarship granting organization Empower Illinois and the Archdiocese of Chicago to create a matching gift pool.

- Every dollar donated to this program through Empower Illinois between Dec. 1, 2019 and Feb. 29, 2020 and designated to a school operated by the Archdiocese of Chicago will be matched with two dollars from this pool (limitations apply). The program will end when all matching funds have been depleted or on Feb. 29, 2020, whichever comes first.
- A \$5,000 donation will have a tremendous impact. With the 75 percent tax credit you receive on the donation and this match, it will have a net cost to you of \$1,250 and will provide \$15,000 in scholarships for low-income families.
- After April 1, 2020, any matching gift program funds that are not awarded at a designated school will be reallocated to low-income students at schools with unmet demand.
- Donors who would like to receive the tax credit for their 2019 taxes should begin the process prior to Dec. 16, 2019 to ensure they have enough time to make their gift by Dec. 31, 2019.

We also want to share with you this message from Cardinal Blase J. Cupich, Archbishop of Chicago, regarding the importance of the tax credit scholarship program. Please visit <https://schools.archchicago.org/tax-credit-scholarships>

The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year, at 1:30pm. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A Baptismal Preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must also be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.
