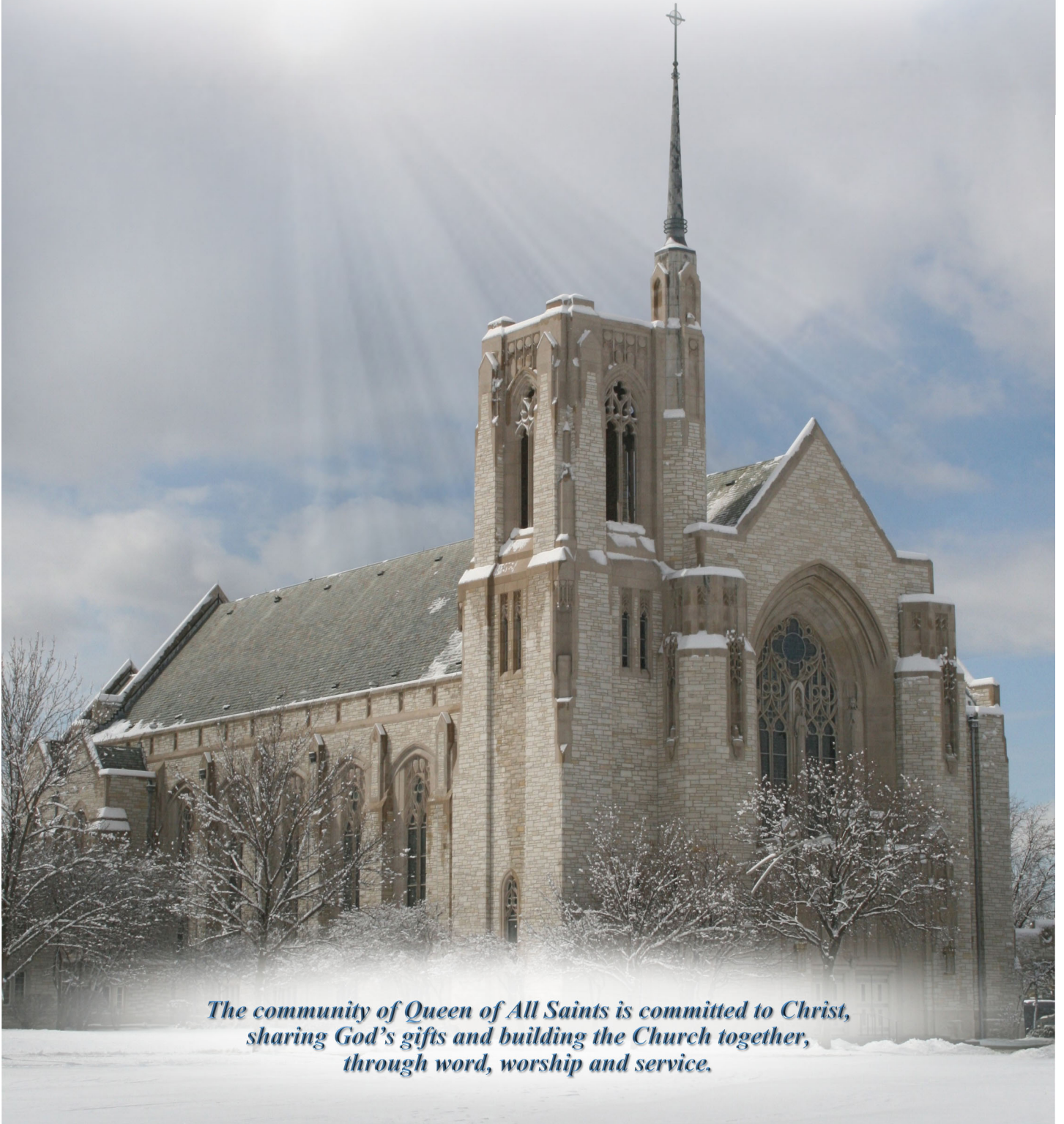

FROM FATHER SIMON



For over sixteen months the bell tower of our beautiful basilica was surrounded by scaffolding and construction fence. It is a great relief to have the scaffolding down and the construction equipment hauled away and see the façade of the basilica in all its glory.

As I mentioned last September, it was water in the choir loft after a heavy rainfall that prompted us to investigate and address the issue. Following an extensive investigation the report from the archdiocesan engineer and the structural engineers from Wiss, Janney, Elstner Associates (WJE) revealed that:

- there are cracks in the mortar joints on the west and north sides of the bell tower that are the primary sources of water infiltration;
- there is displacement of the exterior stone cladding;
- the underlying brick masonry has suffered freeze-thaw damage and poses structural problems;
- about twenty-five lannon stones have significant cracks and spalls and must be replaced;
- spalls and cracks in the limestone need to be repaired;
- the lightning protection system is compromised;
- due to corrosion over time, the base of the cross at the top of the spire and the sphere below it were both split.

It was recommended that this work be done in two phases. The first phase would focus on arresting water infiltration into the structure and the second phase would address structural issues. I am glad to report that we have addressed all of the above-mentioned problems with a ‘we got to get this right this time’ attitude, not only repairing the damage but addressing the cause as well so that we may be able to avoid a recurrence of the problem. It has taken us longer than we expected and cost us a little more than we anticipated.

There are a few more items that need our attention in the spring. One is the landscape around the bell tower and the second, all twenty-nine of the lannon stones that we replaced have turned darker in color after installation. One of the reasons given is that it needs to go through a freeze-thaw cycle to get to the color we had selected that matches the existing stone. In the meantime, we have procured replacement stone from another quarry and may have to install these new stones if we do not see a change in the already replaced stone. If we have to do this, it will be during the summer months, using a cherry-picker rather than scaffolding.

I am grateful to the archdiocesan engineer, WJE, members of the finance council, our business manager, Jerry Farrell, our project manager, Deb Bolash and you for your support throughout this project. I can assure you that we have relied on the best advice of the engineers and the collective wisdom of those concerned to preserve, protect and enhance what we have received so that future generations may give glory to God in a place worthy of the honor of the designation ‘Basilica of Queen of All Saints’. The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated at 1:30pm two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A baptismal preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.

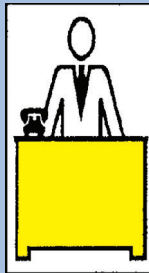
