FROM FATHER SIMON



Our world today has drastically changed from two weeks ago. We are beginning to pay more attention to precautions and symptoms, taking a closer look at estimations of risk for death from coronavirus and case-fatality ratio, while those who have died from natural causes or terminal illness seem like a forgotten statistic and we have come to realize human mortality has no favorites.

Death and dying is both ambiguous and mysterious. I have often wondered how Lazarus, the subject of today's gospel, would describe his death experience. Did he speak about it? What meaning did he attach to it? Did he think it 'scary' and exercise cautious reserve in speaking about it? We simply don't know. Lazarus' silence matters little. Jesus himself clarifies the meaning of this miraculous resuscitation of Lazarus. He announces, "I am the resurrection. If anyone believes in me, even though he dies he will live and whoever lives and believes in me will never die."

The resurrection of Jesus is a portent of what God has in store for all who believe, and as Christians, our ultimate hope is the 'resurrection of the body and life everlasting'. The story of Lazarus points towards this future!

A week after the 90th anniversary celebrations of our parish, I made an appeal at all the Masses for an increase in offertory contributions. I used the phrase: Grateful to the past; mindful of the present; hopeful for the future. I am grateful to all those who have responded to the appeal. Mindful of the present situation, I appeal once again to your generosity to remember your Sunday contributions whether you can give online or drop off your envelope. I thank you in advance for your continued generosity and support. With faith that God is with us through all of this I am hopeful for the future.

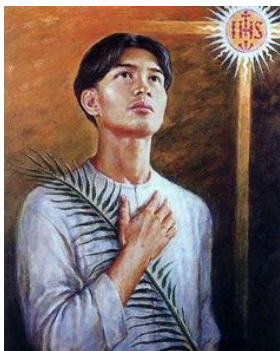

The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated at 1:30pm two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A baptismal preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.

Today's Readings

First Reading - Thus says the Lord God: I will open your graves, have you rise from them, and settle you on your land. Then you shall know I am the Lord, O my people! (Ezekiel 37:12-14).

Psalm - With the Lord there is mercy and fullness of redemption (Psalm 130).

Second Reading - If Christ is in you, the spirit is alive even if the body is dead because of sin (Romans 8:8-11).

Gospel - Lazarus, dead for four days, came out of his tomb when Jesus called his name (John 11:1-45 [3-7, 17, 20-27, 33b-45]).

A note about our readings today -

As we approach Holy Week, our readings speak of a God who, in the midst of death, brings new life to the people. In Ezekiel, we hear that God will open the graves of the people of Israel, who faced near extinction. In the Gospel of John, Jesus gives new life to Lazarus in a manner that prefigures the resurrection of Jesus. Paul tells the Romans that in Christ, God will not only give life to our bodies after death, but God offers us abundant life here and now. We observe that the external conditions for the people described in these readings did not radically change. Israel was still in exile. Lazarus would eventually face death again. But now God's presence and power are revealed. Even when our situation in life is difficult and perhaps not likely to change soon, we remember that the Spirit dwells within us.

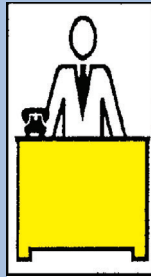
