

FROM FATHER SIMON



Great News! The Archdiocese has approved and certified us ready to open the basilica for a modified Phase I of the reopening plan it carefully crafted for parishes. This includes that we are now able to celebrate funerals, weddings and baptism with a maximum of 10 attendees. I know this will bring some comfort and relief to families who have lost a loved one and have not had the opportunity to celebrate a funeral mass. It will also bring joy to parents who are waiting to have their children baptized.

The parish reopening leadership team will continue to deliberate on moving forward to open the basilica for private prayer. We hope to have a solid plan in place by the beginning of this week and seek the approval and certification from the Archdiocese to go ahead with our plans. We will continue to keep you informed of the developments through the weekly newsletter and social media.

Last Friday 67 eighth graders graduated from Queen of All Saints School. This celebration is something they will never forget as I told them – ‘the Class of 2020 will be remembered for what they lost due to COVID19 but for how they adapted and responded to the reality we find ourselves in.’ Some have spent as many as eleven years in our school. They are heading off to 14 different high schools in the Chicagoland area and around the country. We wish them the very best wherever life’s journey takes them. We ask you graduates to remember that you always have a home here at Queen of All Saints parish.

This weekend we celebrate the great feast of Pentecost. St. Pope John XXIII he prayed as he announced the Second Vatican Council “Renew your wonders in our time, as though for a new Pentecost.” This prayer is just as appropriate today, especially in view of the problems we face in the Church and in the world. One of the most obvious issues is our ability to gather and celebrate the Eucharist as a faith community. We feel within us a deep hunger for the Eucharist, a longing to gather as a community which can simply be discouraging – especially for those who do go to Mass and those who believe the Church could offer people good news that is very relevant to their lives.

If we are feeling this way, however, we might find some consolation in remembering that the first Christians were troubled too. After Jesus’ crucifixion, they felt lost without his presence. It is particularly when we are troubled or anxious that Pentecost is such wonderful news. It is the Feast of Divine Surprise, Life, and Delight.

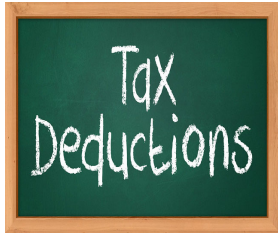
The Spirit is given as Jesus had promised before his departure. The Spirit that Jesus breathed into the disciples is the same Spirit breathed into us. The presence of the Spirit in us is also the constant assurance Jesus gives to us that he will always be with us, in ways we never expected or even imagined. It is the Spirit of Life and Mission. We are asked not to be afraid but rather to receive the Spirit of peace, joy and life with open hearts and to be led by the Spirit to new possibilities of living. So, do not be afraid or lose heart. The Spirit will renew his wonders in our time, for the Spirit has already been breathed into us. May each of you experience a new Pentecost in your heart.

NEW TAX DEDUCTION



There is a new tax deduction for charitable contributions even if you take the standard deduction. The CARES Act (Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act) provides a new tax deduction for those who do not itemize.

Starting in 2020, charitable donations can be deducted from taxable income up to \$300 per person, or \$600 for joint filers.

Please consider this as you plan your 2020 charitable gifts to Queen of All Saints.

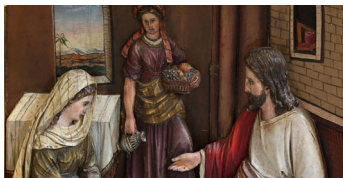
SOCIAL JUSTICE MINISTRY

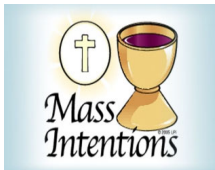

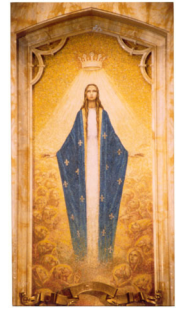

TEXT TO GIVE

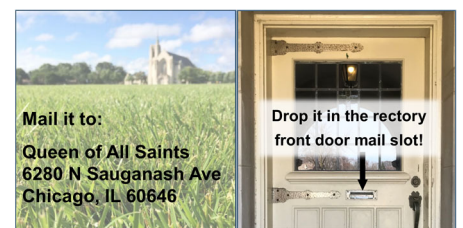
- If you currently have an active GiveCentral account, you may use the cell phone registered to your account to give by text.
 - The phone number to give by text is 773-661-4683.
 - To make a Sunday donation send a text with the keyword “*sundayqas*” followed by an amount (e.g., to **make a \$100 donation to Sunday collections, text: *sundayqas 100***). To make an Easter donation text “easter” followed by the amount. Leave a space between the keyword and the amount.
 - If you do not have a GiveCentral account, you may still text the same way to the same number which will then return a link that will allow you to enter your contact and payment information for your donation.
- At this time, donations may only be made to Sunday and Easter using Text to Give.

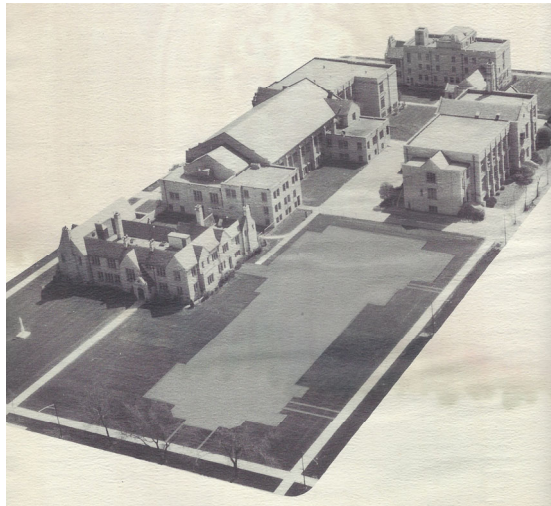

**A Path to Reopening
Volunteers Needed!**

Here is what our parish campus looked like in 1955, when nearly all our buildings had been erected. Something very essential is missing - you!



We need volunteers to assist with our parish reopening plan who are not part of a “vulnerable population” (that is, not over the age of 65, no underlying medical condition such as diabetes or lung disease, undergoing cancer treatment, etc.).

We need volunteers to:

- manage the flow of worshipers as they enter and exit the church as well as the reception of Holy Communion
- make sure attendees use hand sanitizer upon entering the church and before receiving Communion
- see that all are wearing a mask, and are reminded not to enter if ill
- direct people to appropriate seating and waiting areas, etc.
- help with cleaning, if required.

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Before there was water, there was fire. Once in a while, a volcano hints at the sizzling magma upon which the whole human enterprise floats. Over eons, the surface cooled off a bit, and rain sizzled down for thousands of centuries, filling the oceans and sculpting the earth. We Christians can catch God's glory in a shimmering pool of water, but we can also capture God's burning desire to fan the tiny flames of our baptismal candles into something that will make a difference.

In Sicily to this day, there is a custom of scattering rose petals down from the ceiling of church on the heads of the faithful, an effective reminder of the "tongues of flame" descending on the apostles, and a sign that the Holy Spirit still is poured out on the baptized. It is not merely a quaint custom, but a fairly potent sign of what baptism does. An interesting sidebar: if you have traced the Epiphany blessing on your doorway in chalk, Pentecost is the day to erase it. From now on, no need to rely on the "wise men"- you are alive in the Spirit!

The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated at 1:30pm two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A baptismal preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.

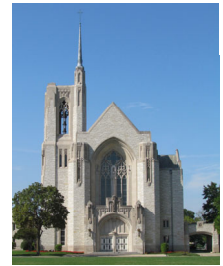

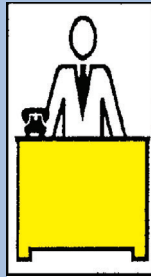
