During this time of social distancing, we are all concerned about large crowd gatherings and are extremely cautious about staying in a hotel, rental home or cabin in the woods. Among the many industries affected by this pandemic, I am sure you would agree that the hospitality industry – hotels, restaurants, cruises, events, tourism, amusement parks and the like – have taken a big hit. Those working in this service industry are uncertain of their future as are many others who have lost their jobs or whose hours have been cut.

Hospitality is more than just about economics. It is a biblical mandate. There are some wonderful stories of hospitality in the Scriptures. The scripture for this weekend is a description of Elisha, on his travels, being provided with his own room, complete with bedside lamp which conjures up a comforting picture. His kind hostess and her elderly husband receive a rich reward for their generosity. The gift of a child must have been far beyond their wildest dreams, but follows a pattern throughout the Old and New Testaments in which the gift of a child is God's ultimate blessing.

Most of us learned new ways of being hospitable - shopping for elderly parents, preparing food and handing it over to them at their door. We at the rectory graciously appreciate all who brought us food when 'shelter in place' was in order. Thank you!

The Elizabeth Ministry in our parish strives to live out the biblical mandate 'to welcome the stranger and provide for the widow and the orphan.' They work quietly preparing and providing meals to those in our parish who have a sick child or parent that needs the full attention of the family or to families grieving the loss of a loved one. They not only help with meals but at times provide baby-sitting and more importantly as a faith-community, take turns to pray for the families. I am grateful for their silent but essential and powerful witness to the call that 'whatever we do to the least of our brothers and sisters, we do to the Lord.'

NEW TAX DEDUCTION

There is a new tax deduction for charitable contributions even if you take the standard deduction. The CARES Act (Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act) provides a new tax deduction for those who do not itemize. Starting in 2020, charitable donations can be deducted from taxable income up to \$300 per person, or \$600 for joint filers. Please consider this as you plan your 2020 charitable gifts to Queen of All Saints.



RELIGIOUS EDUCATION REGISTRATION

Registration for Religious Education 2020-2021 is now open!

The QASRE program begins at kindergarten and goes through eighth grade. Our program focuses on building a relationship with Christ as your children grow in their discipleship.

Students wanting to participate in the sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation must attend a minimum of two years of Religious Education as per the archdiocesan requirement. First Reconciliation and Communion preparation begins at 1st grade. Confirmation preparation begins at 7th grade.

IMMIGRATION RESOURCES FROM THE SOCIAL JUSTICE MINISTRY

The US Supreme Court's decision on Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) last Thursday put the spotlight on the DACA program, and more broadly, the issue of immigration.



What is DACA? Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) is a United States immigration policy introduced in 2012 by President Barack Obama that allows some individuals who were brought to the US as children under the age of 16, have clean criminal records, and lack any lawful immigration status to receive a renewable two-year period of deferred action from deportation and become eligible for a work permit. DACA does not provide a path to citizenship. DACA recipients are often nicknamed "Dreamers". [US Citizenship & Immigration Services \(USCIS\) data](#) indicates the US has 788,000 approved DACA recipients. (COVID-19 related factoid: [American Medical Association estimates the 27,000 DACA recipients working in US healthcare](#) will touch the lives of over 5 million patients over the course of their careers.)

What was the US Supreme Court's Decision? The court, in a 5-4 opinion written by Chief Justice John Roberts, said the administration acted arbitrarily when it moved to end the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals program, failing to offer adequate reasons for doing so. Significantly, the Supreme Court did not rule on the legality of the DACA program, nor did it resolve the immigration status of the

DACA recipients. As a result, per [Homeland Security's webpage on DACA](#), "Due to a federal court order, USCIS (US Citizenship & Immigration Services) has resumed accepting requests to renew a grant of deferred action under DACA. USCIS is not accepting requests from individuals who have never before been granted deferred action under DACA."

PARISH WEBSITE

Go onto the parish website and click on “Mass Reservation.” Then click on signup labeled “here.” Signups for the weekend and following week are available every Wednesday.

PASSWORD

To sign up for a weekend Mass you will need to use a password. This password will be emailed every Wednesday before the weekend Masses. There is no password required for weekday Masses.

3

CHOOSING A MASS TIME

Look through the Mass times and check “sign up” under the Mass time you want to attend then select “submit and sign up” at the bottom of the page.

4

MAKING A RESERVATION

Put your name, email, and phone number in the designated slots. Then elect “sign up now.”

If you have 1-4 people in your reservation, make one reservation. If you have 5-8 people in your reservation, make two reservations. Do not include people living outside of your household in your reservation.

5

CONGRATULATIONS

You have officially signed up to attend Mass. You will receive a reminder email two days before the date of your reservation.

The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated on Saturdays. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A baptismal preparation class for the parents is required. Please contact the rectory for further details. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.


Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Our readings today could be seen as a simple recipe for right living. In the Hebrew Bible, hospitality is regarded as one of the highest virtues. Conditions were harsh, and when people received guests or strangers, they washed their feet, provided a meal, and offered shelter if they could. In Second Kings, a woman's generosity is rewarded with the prospect of a child. In Romans we are called to recognize our baptism in Christ. We are called to be "dead to sin, and living in Christ Jesus." In the Gospel passage from Saint Luke, Jesus bids us to take up our cross, and to receive others as if we were receiving Christ. Put them together, and all of them are a call to see the holy, to see God in others, and to live our lives in Christ.


