FROM FATHER SIMON



Over the past few months, many new words have been added to our vocabulary, a few whose meaning has been reinterpreted and other commonly used terms redefined.

All of this has made us realize the power of words, written or spoken. In our effort to be sensitive to others, many of us weigh our words before speaking. The words we speak or write, or the words spoken to us are revealing and can awaken in us or others a part of ourselves that we never knew existed. It can change our mind, attitude and life.

Our readings this weekend focus on the power of God's word. We are blessed to hear the word of God proclaimed at our eucharistic celebrations and are able read them whenever we want. God's word can bring us comfort, calm our fears and challenge us to change. Let us remind ourselves as we listen to God's word this weekend, that it is a lamp to our feet and a light to our path. May the words we speak or write bring comfort, joy and blessing to others.

Update about our re-opening: It is three weeks since we reopened and we have had an opportunity to evaluate our schedule of services in the basilica. The cleaning, disinfecting and sanitizing of the basilica remains our top-priority for our safety and the safety of all who come to worship in this sacred space. Thank you for your understanding and patience. As a result of our evaluation we have made a few changes to our schedule of baptisms, funerals and weddings.

Baptisms: Given the fact that our last Mass on Sunday ends at about 2 pm and we need an hour to clean, we are moving baptisms to Saturdays (when a wedding has not been scheduled) at 2 pm, beginning Labor Day. This will give us enough time on Saturday for funerals and the Saturday evening Mass. We will limit to baptizing no more than four (4) infants with a maximum of twenty (20) persons for each family in attendance.

Funerals: We will celebrate funerals in the basilica at 10 am and 12 noon with a limit of one hundred and fifty (150) persons in attendance. The family along with the funeral home will provide us the names and contact information of those in attendance. This requirement is mandated by the Archdiocese of Chicago and the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH). There will be no time for visitation in the basilica.

Weddings: Almost all of our weddings scheduled for this year have been rescheduled. We will honor the date and time of previously scheduled weddings. However, moving forward, we will be able to have only ONE wedding on Fridays at 4 pm and ONE wedding on Saturdays at 2 pm. Weddings will be limited to one hundred and fifty (150) persons in attendance. The family will provide us the names and contact information of those in attendance. This requirement

is mandated by the Archdiocese of Chicago and the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH).

Given the uncertain nature of this pandemic, we will continue to evaluate our schedule of liturgies in the basilica. If there are any changes, they will be effective after Labor Day. Please be mindful that if the current situation changes, we are obligated to follow the directives of the Archdiocese and the State of Illinois which may affect the schedule and or the number of people permitted.

Summer projects in the parish and school: While we have postponed the final phase of our Capital Campaign that mainly focused on the parish center, we have completed the asbestos abatement of the affected areas in preparation for the work to be completed next summer. We are upgrading our electrical systems and capacity to provide for our enhanced future needs. Beginning June 13, we will be without power for at least ten days, and will not be able to run the air-conditioning in the basilica. During this time we will bring in a generator to power the lights and sound in the basilica and rectory. Thank you for your patience and understanding and pray for cooler weather.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION REGISTRATION

Registration for Religious Education 2020-2021 is now open!

The QASRE program begins at kindergarten and goes through eighth grade. Our program focuses on building a relationship with Christ as your children grow in their discipleship.

Students wanting to participate in the sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation must attend a minimum of two years of Religious Education as per the archdiocesan requirement. First Reconciliation and Communion preparation begins at 1st grade. Confirmation preparation begins at 7th grade.

PARISH WEBSITE

Go onto the parish website and click on “Mass Reservation.” Then click on signup labeled “here.” Sign ups for the weekend and following week are available every Wednesday.

PASSWORD

To sign up for a weekend Mass you will need to use a password. This password will be emailed every Wednesday before the weekend Masses. There is no password required for weekday Masses

CHOOSING A MASS TIME

Look through the Mass times and check “sign up” under the Mass time you want to attend then select “submit and sign up” at the bottom of the page.

MAKING A RESERVATION

To attend the Mass, make one reservation (Quantity = 1) and in the white box, indicate the total number of people in your household that are attending. Please do not include people living outside of your household in your reservation.

Add your first, last name and email in the designated boxes and then click the “sign up now.”

CONGRATULATIONS

You have officially signed up to attend Mass. You will receive a reminder email two days before the date of your reservation.



DRIVE-IN MASS

We are happy to announce that our Sunday 7 am Mass is scheduled as a “drive-in” Mass in our parking lot, weather and other logistics permitting. **This Mass has limited capacity and is especially designed for the more vulnerable members of our parish who are not comfortable attending Mass in the basilica due to age, mobility, immune status or other health issues.** Some tips to efficiently ensure the health of our fellow parishioners:

- Make a reservation for your car (one reservation per household) for the 7 am Sunday Mass. The on-line link to register will be sent on Wednesday. Everyone who attends this Mass must arrive in a car and remain inside their car for the duration of the Mass.
- The parking lot will open at 6:30 am and will close at 7:05 am – so that our celebration will not be disturbed by those arriving late.
- All cars will be parked facing west, and a temporary altar (**marked in blue**) will be set at the west end of the parking lot on a short platform.
- Cars will be parked socially distant, similar to how the pews in the church are arranged - for each row, cars are to be parked in every other spot in the row, diagonally to the car in front of you. (**Please see the map below or the red spots mark the area to which the ushers will direct you**). This allows cars to be parked with open windows and provide for better viewing of the altar and access for the reception of Holy Communion.
- Please form a line to enter the parking lot from the north end starting at Sauganash and Lemont Avenues (**the area in green**). Please do not use Keene Avenue. This will allow us to arrange parking spots in an orderly fashion. We will direct all cars to exit from the south end of the parking lot (**the area in purple**).
- The Mass will be broadcast on a low-power FM frequency which you can hear on your car radio. The frequency of our broadcast will be posted in the parking lot.
- Communion will be distributed through your open car window. Please use your own hand sanitizer before receiving Communion.
- Please do not park on Keene or Sauganash Avenues. It is unlikely that our radio transmission will reach you and Communion will not be distributed there.

We expect Mass to take less than 45 minutes.



IMMIGRATION RESOURCES FROM THE SOCIAL JUSTICE MINISTRY

The recent US Supreme Court's decision on Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) put the spotlight on the DACA program, and more broadly, the issue of immigration.

What is DACA? Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) is a United States immigration policy introduced in 2012 by President Barack Obama that allows some individuals who were brought to the US as children under the age of 16, have clean criminal records, and lack any lawful immigration status to receive a renewable two-year period of deferred action from deportation and become eligible for a work permit. DACA does not provide a path to citizenship. DACA recipients are often nicknamed "Dreamers". [US Citizenship & Immigration Services \(USCIS\) data](#) indicates the US has 788,000 approved DACA recipients. (COVID-19 related factoid: [the American Medical Association estimates that the 27,000 DACA recipients working in US healthcare](#) will touch the lives of over 5 million patients over the course of their careers.)



What was the US Supreme Court's Decision? The court, in a 5-4 opinion written by Chief Justice John Roberts, said the administration acted arbitrarily when it moved to end the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals program, failing to offer adequate reasons for doing so. Significantly, the Supreme Court did not rule on the legality of the DACA program, nor did it resolve the immigration status of the

DACA recipients. As a result, per [Homeland Security's webpage on DACA](#), "Due to a federal court order, USCIS (US Citizenship & Immigration Services) has resumed accepting requests to renew a grant of deferred action under DACA. USCIS is not accepting requests from individuals who have never before been granted deferred action under DACA."

STEWARSHIP DIRECT CONTRIBUTIONS FROM YOUR IRA

If you are 70½ or older and have an IRA, you may qualify for a charitable giving opportunity directly from your IRA.

- You are now allowed to make direct transfers from an IRA to Queen of All Saints Parish.
- This is an ideal situation even for those who do not itemize deductions since the withdrawal is not considered taxable income.
- Our parish will receive 100% of your transfer.
- You can transfer up to \$100,000 annually.
- Although the required minimum distribution rule has been temporarily suspended for 2020, remember that for future years this type of transfer can be credited against your RMD.

The tax-free nature of this withdrawal may have a number of other favorable benefits affecting your tax return, depending on your particular situation, such as reduced taxes on Social Security distributions or future Medicare premiums.

NEW TAX DEDUCTION FOR CHARITABLE CONTRIBUTIONS-EVEN IF YOU TAKE THE STANDARD DEDUCTION

The new **CARES Act** (Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act) provides a new tax deduction even for those who do not itemize.

Starting in 2020, charitable donations can be deducted from your taxable income up to \$300 per person, or \$600 for joint filers.

Please consider this as you plan your 2020 charitable gifts to Queen of All Saints.

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated on Saturdays. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A baptismal preparation class for the parents is required. Please contact the rectory for further details. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.




