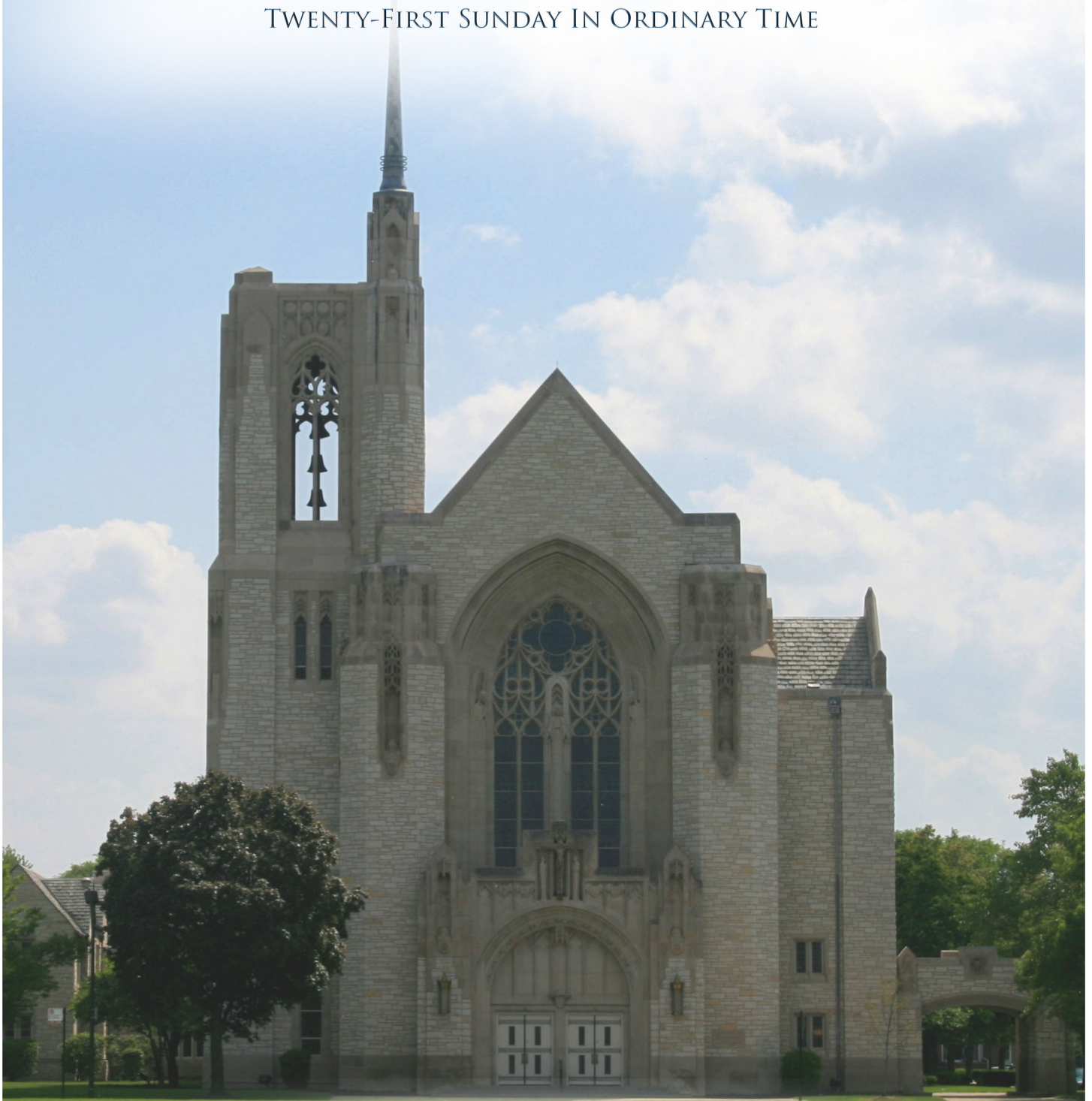

## FROM FATHER SIMON



On August 26, 2020, when Queen of All Saints School opens its doors to welcome students to a new school year for the 81st time, it will be under totally different circumstances. The kids themselves will have another piece of clothing added to their wardrobe – face masks. The classrooms will look a little different with desks spaced out to maintain social distance. There will be several entry points into the school building as well as recording the temperatures of the students as they arrive. All of these necessary precautions are put in place, following the guidelines of the Archdiocese Office of Catholic Schools (OCS), as we continue our lives in the reality that surrounds us.

I want to assure you, parents, that our principal Emily Carlson, along with her teaching staff, members of the parish staff, maintenance crew and parents are all part of the reopening team. After in-depth discussions with all these affected groups, our reopening plan, submitted by Mrs. Carlson to the OCS for final certification to open, has been accepted. While we have done all that is required, and even more to ensure the safety of our children and teachers, there will still be many things that we will have to adapt to as we learn on the fly the ever-changing reality of dealing with the unknowns. So, I ask for your continued patience and support.

I also want to thank you for entrusting your child to our care and education. I know that your child's education and future are very important to you. The fact that you are making the sacrifice to send your child to a Catholic school is a sign that you want only the best for your child. And so do we! Please be assured that we will work very hard to provide the education that will help ensure the future you wish for your child. While we will do all that we can to provide a rich, solid Catholic education, you too are a vital part of your child's education. In support of your child's education we look forward to your presence and participation in our school, parish life and parish activities!

Finally, in trying to acquaint myself with the legacy of my predecessors, I just want to let you know what Msgr. Dolan had to say at a time when our school was still in its early stages of growth and before the basilica was even built, with regard to Queen of All Saints School and children . . .

“We started out with a firm resolution to put first things first -- to provide for our children before all else. We never wavered, never deviated from that principle. No matter how urgent our need for a church, no matter how much discomfort we suffered in our inadequate place of worship, we held to the principle of building the parish around the school and the recreational needs of our youth.”

As we journey together to provide a wonderful education for your student, let us place each child into the care and protection of our patroness Mary, Queen of All Saints! May your child grow in knowledge, grace and love! An education that recognizes the importance of the spiritual will, in the end, make a healthy, happy and holy person!

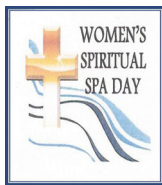

The QASRE program begins at kindergarten and goes through eighth grade. Our program focuses on building a relationship with Christ as your children grow in their discipleship.

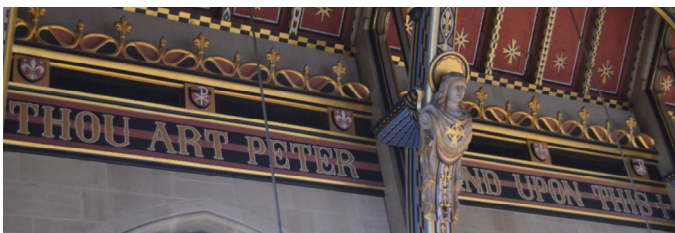

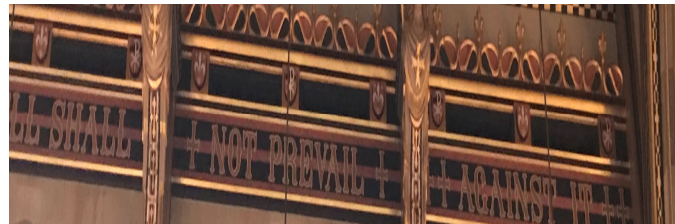

## CATECHISTS NEEDED FOR RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

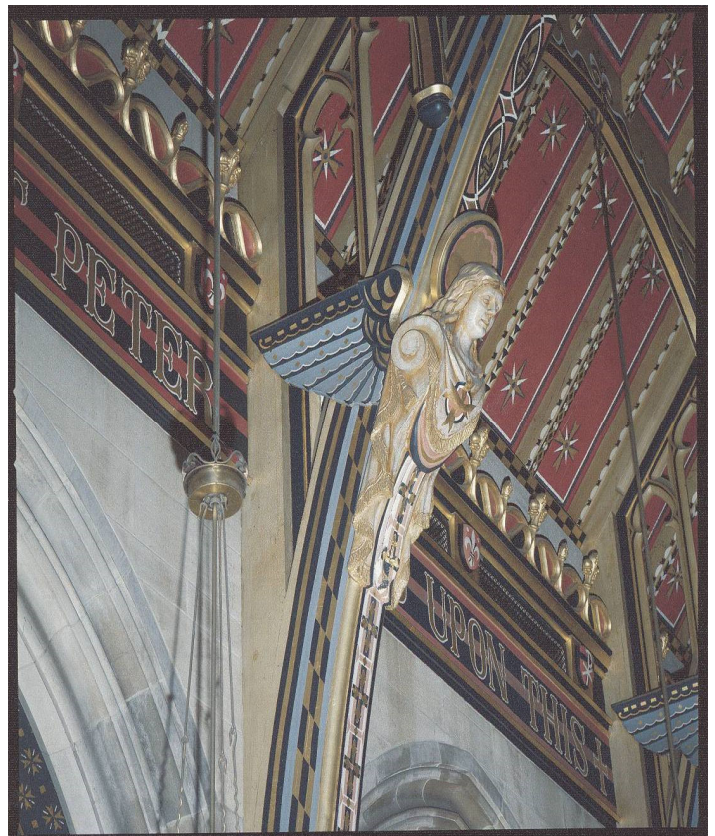

## STEWARDSHIP IN TIME OF COVID-19

### DON'T FORGET OUR CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

In these difficult times it's good to step back and remind ourselves what we have accomplished and what dreams are still incomplete. What our generosity has done so far is truly magnificent:

#### **We completed Phase I of our capital campaign, the comprehensive renovation and repurposing of the Benedict Center:**

- State of the art classrooms for our 3 and 4 year old early childhood education programs
- New gathering spaces for our adult ministries
- All new electrical wiring, plumbing and HVAC
- Dedicated space for our Special Religious Education Program
- Enhanced fire safety and security features, plus elevator access for the elderly and disabled

#### **And then we completed Phase II:**

- The renovation of the former kindergarten space for use by our larger ministries, including the Men's Club and Women's Auxiliary
- Reconfiguration of classrooms, library, music program area, into updated and more appropriate space

#### **And now we are getting ready for Phase III:**

- Due to the interruption in our finances and parish life due to COVID-19 we slowed down Phase III and only completed certain preliminary work, namely some asbestos abatement and the upgrade of the electrical supply to the older parts of our campus to handle our future needs.
- In 2021, finally we will complete the creation of a flexible parish community hall in the former Rose Room, restoring that space to its original function.

Our costs may be in a modest and temporary slowdown but we ask everyone to stay current on their pledges so that our construction program can stay on schedule for next year.

## The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated on Saturdays. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A baptismal preparation class for the parents is required. Please contact the rectory for further details. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

## The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

## Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.
