## FROM FATHER SIMON



Actions speak louder than words. We have all heard this statement and we know it is the simple truth. Another core value linked to this truth is integrity. Integrity implies being truthful and honest, reliable and authentic, the same you, whether people are watching or not. This is what we want for ourselves. This is what we long to see and find in others.

In the Gospel this weekend, once more we are in the vineyard. When I think about the parable of the two sons being asked to go out and work, I ask myself which son was I when my dad would ask me to accomplish some task. I decided I was somewhere in the middle. I can't imagine simply saying "no." But there were times when my "yes" was preceded by excuses or followed by interior whining and foot dragging. Eventually I would head into the task.

The lesson of the parable for us is to be attentive to the call to conversion in our lives and recognize that actions are more important than intentions. Actions do speak louder than words and as the first reading this weekend notes, conversion to good action can override the bad actions of the past while present or future bad actions negate the good of the past.

Conversion is not only about the moment of change from a state of disbelief to full faith in God, Jesus and his Church. Nor is conversion just about a dramatic change in behavior that is the result of setting aside serious past behaviors that are contrary to God's love and destructive of self and others. Conversion is about the ongoing attitude and effort of trying to do better with God's help. It is about wanting to be a more effective worker in the vineyard, not so that our actions are louder, but that they bring about greater knowledge of Jesus and the value of following him. Ongoing conversion is about responding to Jesus' call to grow in perfection. We can be better 'pray-ers'. We can be better spouses, parents, children, brothers, sisters and friends. Some of us can even be better priests. We can be better responsible members of the great community of the human race, calling us to love the stranger and even the perceived enemy.

Every morning when we awake, we should imagine Jesus sending us out to work in his vineyard and resolve to take the day, one step at a time, one choice, one action, always attentive to doing that which will match what we believe.

- ACKNOWLEDGE** the severity and difficulty of the situation.
- BE SUPPORTIVE. LISTEN.** Keep an open mind.
- REAFFIRM** that he/she should not stay in an abusive relationship.
- HELP** develop a safety plan.
- BE NON-JUDGMENTAL.**
- ENCOURAGE** him/her to spend time with family and friends outside of the relationship.
- PROVIDE** phone numbers and website addresses for help services and local shelters.
- SUGGEST** opening a checking or savings account if possible.

**REMEMBER THAT YOU CANNOT "RESCUE" A VICTIM; HE/SHE HAS TO MAKE OWN CHOICES.**  
Whether or not the victim ends the relationship, continue to be supportive.

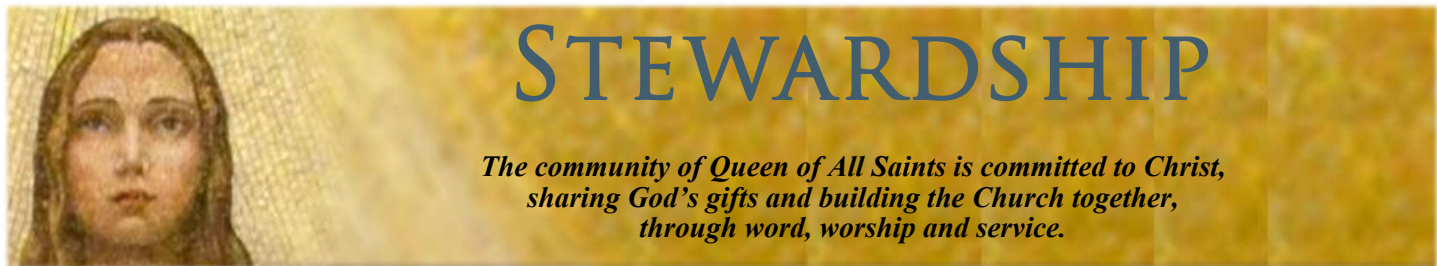

## The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated on Saturdays. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A baptismal preparation class for the parents is required. Please contact the rectory for further details. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

## The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

## Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.

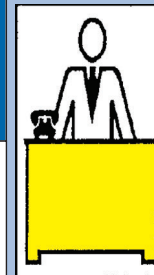
