THANKSGIVING MASS - THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 26, 10AM

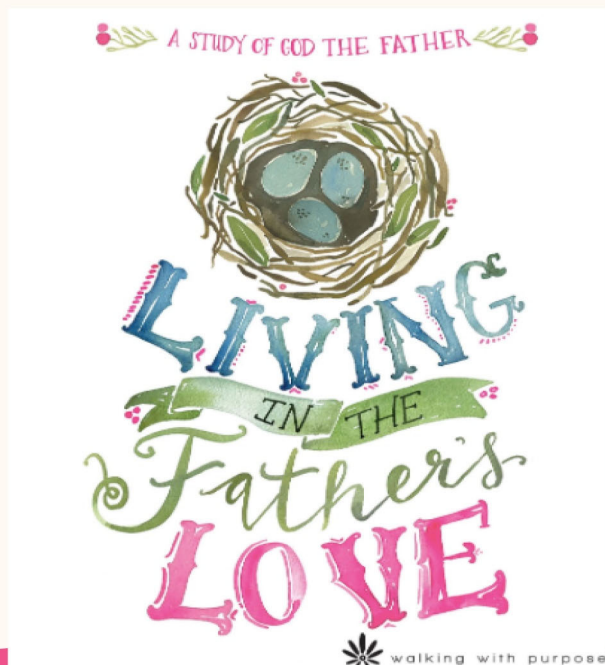

WHAT IS HAPPENING IN RCIA

Each week the inquirers and RCIA team start our session by breaking open with the gospel passage from Sunday's Mass. Some of the passages have been simple for us to explore, such as the greatest commandment, *you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind... You shall love your neighbor as yourself.* Other passages have been harder to decipher, such as the parable of the wedding banquet. Both passages, whether difficult or straightforward, are meant to challenge us. Following the gospel messages are never supposed to be easy. And like the gospel, the RCIA process does a lot of challenging. Our Catholic faith is beautiful and complex, and it is meant to challenge us daily. As Catholics we are made to listen to the Sunday gospel, be filled spiritually by the Eucharist and go out into the world being the hands and feet of Christ. There is nothing easy about being Christ in the world.

Right now, our inquirers are still in the "period of inquiry." Each of them has answered a call from God to be part of RCIA. This period is so important because all of our inquirers are exploring that call from God to be part of the Catholic Church. The call can be challenging in itself. Which is why our inquirers need you. They need our parish community to support and pray for them.

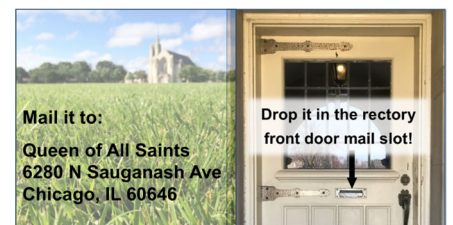
- If you currently have an active GiveCentral account, you may use the cell phone registered to your account to give by text.

STEWARDSHIP IN TIME OF COVID-19 DON'T FORGET OUR CAPITAL CAMPAIGN!

In these difficult times it's good to step back and remind ourselves what we have accomplished and what dreams are still incomplete. What our generosity has done so far is truly magnificent:

We completed Phase I of our capital campaign, the comprehensive renovation and repurposing of the Benedict Center:

- State of the art classrooms for our 3 and 4 year old early childhood education programs
- New gathering spaces for our adult ministries
- All new electrical wiring, plumbing and HVAC
- Dedicated space for our Special Religious Education Program
- Enhanced fire safety and security features, plus elevator access for the elderly and disabled

And then we completed Phase II:

- The renovation of the former kindergarten space for use by our larger ministries, including the Men's Club and Women's Auxiliary
- Reconfiguration of classrooms, library, music program area into updated and more appropriate space

And now we are getting ready for Phase III:

- Due to the interruption in our finances and parish life due to COVID-19 we slowed down Phase III and only completed certain preliminary work, namely some asbestos abatement and the upgrade of the electrical supply to the older parts of our campus to handle our future needs
- In 2021, finally we will complete the creation of a flexible parish community hall in the former Rose Room, restoring that space to its original function.

Our costs may be in a modest and temporary slowdown but we ask everyone to stay current on their pledges so that our construction program can stay on schedule for next year.

The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the sacrament of baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The sacrament of baptism for infants is celebrated on Saturdays. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A baptismal preparation class for the parents is required. Please contact the rectory for further details. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the anointing of the sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.

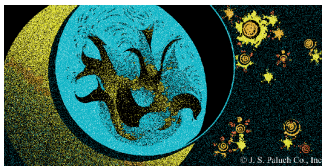
